**DEFENDANT STATE FARM'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR
ENLARGEMENT OF THE PAGE LIMITATION FOR ITS POST-TRIAL BRIEF**

Defendant State Farm Fire and Casualty Company ("State Farm") files this Unopposed Motion for Enlargement of the Page Limitation for Its Post-Trial Brief, which brief will be filed in support of the Motion of State Farm for Partial Judgment Notwithstanding the Verdict and for New Trial ("Motion"). In support, State Farm states as follows:

1. Pursuant to Uniform Local Rule 7.2(E), State Farm's page limit is a combined 35 pages for its principal brief and its reply brief.
2. State Farm submits that 10 additional pages are necessary due to the nature of the important issues that are to be raised in its Motion. This is the first Katrina-related jury trial in which several of these issues have been raised. Thus, it is important that they be given proper attention and fully briefed since, regardless of how the Court rules, these issues are likely to be appealed.
3. Counsel for Plaintiffs has informed counsel for State Farm that Plaintiffs consent to the additional pages. State Farm also consents to affording Plaintiffs 10 additional pages in their briefing in response to State Farm's Motion.

WHEREFORE, State Farm respectfully requests that it be afforded a total of 45 pages for its principal brief and reply brief concerning its Motion for Partial Judgment Notwithstanding the Verdict and for New Trial. It is also requested that Plaintiffs be afforded a total of 45 pages for their brief in response to State Farm's Motion. State Farm also requests such other general or special relief to which it is entitled.
