Re: Lott v. State Farm / McIntosh v. State Farm


Dear General Hood,

As you are aware, we represent Senator Lott and the McIntoshes in pending lawsuits against State Farm. To date, these cases have not settled, and we are rapidly approaching discovery deadlines and trial dates in both cases. We believe that State Farm documents previously provided to your office by the whistleblowers Cori and Kerri Rigsby, which your office subsequently provided to lawyers for E.A. Renfroe, are highly relevant to the issues in both lawsuits.

Accordingly, please accept this letter as our respectful request for copies of all State Farm documents that your office voluntarily provided E.A. Renfroe last month. Because it is our understanding that your office agreed to provide these documents to Renfroe only after suspending its Grand Jury investigation, we are only requesting the documents that your office provided to Renfroe.

Thank you in advance for your attention to this matter. Please advise us as soon as conveniently possible if your office will require a subpoena from the United States District Court presiding over the Lott and McIntosh cases.
