ORDER

At this court's regular motion docket on November 16, 2007, the court heard oral argument on the special motion filed by the Mississippi Department of Insurance ("the Department") for access to the documents delivered to counsel for plaintiff, E.A. Renfroe & Company, Inc. ("Renfroe"), by defendants, Cori Rigsby and Kerri Rigsby ("the Rigsbys"), in response to this court's preliminary injunction, and since that time held by the court under protective procedures. Finding the Department's motion well taken in large part, but understanding the problems raised by Renfroe and by the Rigsbys, the Department's motion is GRANTED to the extent of allowing as many as two representatives of the Department to examine but not to remove the documents held by the court, using the court's jury room to review the documents and to select any document or documents the Department wishes to copy for its use in its investigation of State Farm, and for no other purpose. All selected documents shall first be submitted to the court for its approval for copying. Objections by Renfroe or by



the Rigsbys to specific documents will not be entertained. Any documents approved by the court for use by the Department shall be copied by the court and delivered to the Department. A list of all such documents shall be kept by the court and shall be shared with counsel for Renfroe and for the Rigsbys. To the extent this order does not accommodate the objections filed by Renfroe and the Rigsbys to the Department's motion, the objections are OVERRULED.
